## Archery Fun – July 18!

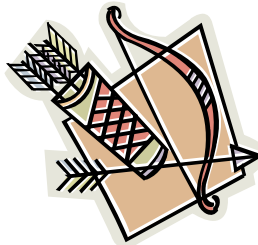

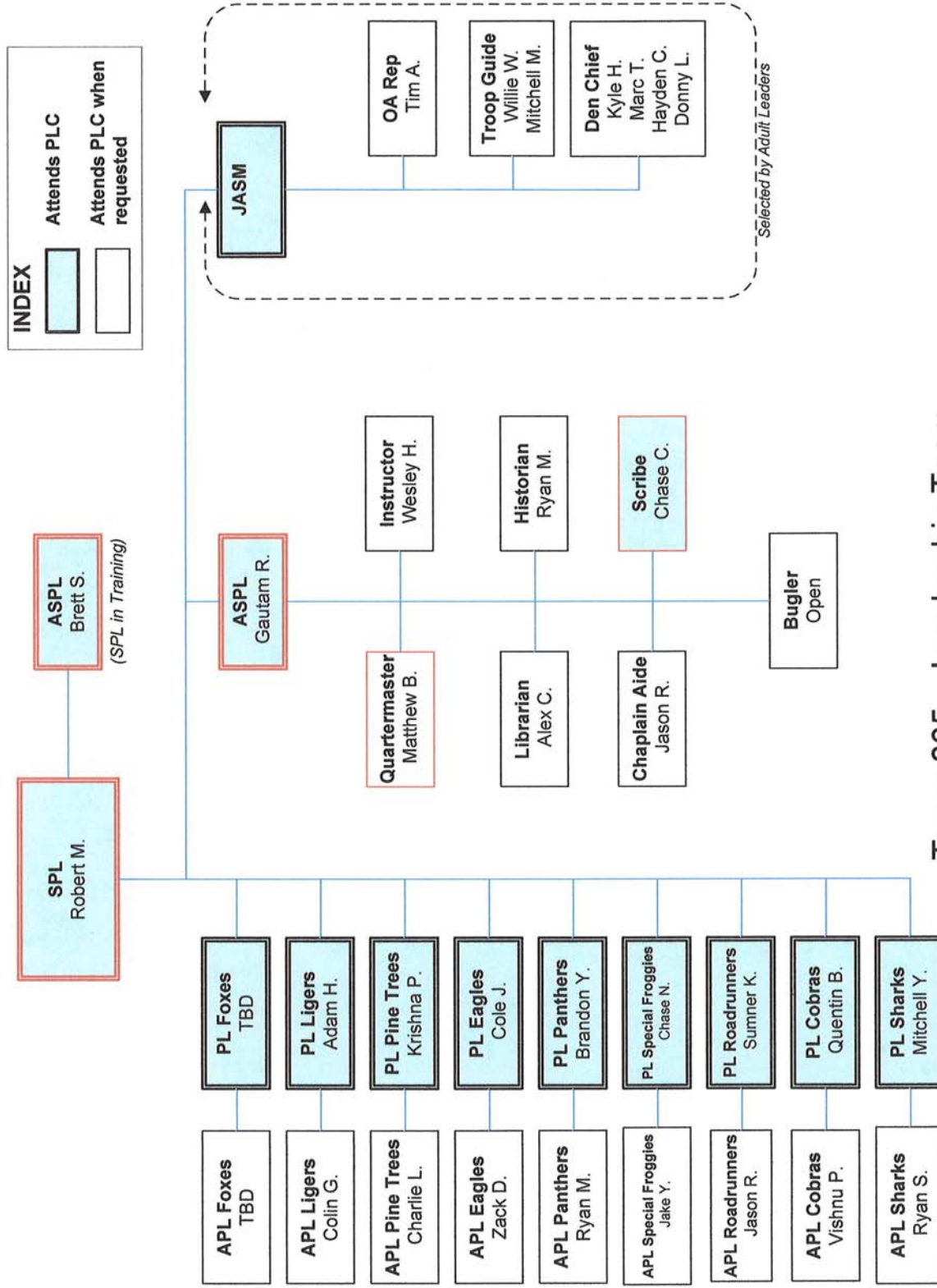
