Wente Summer Camp Highlights

Located in the hills surrounding Willits, CA, Wente Scout Reservation was a beautiful location for our week at camp. The weather started out hot, hot, hot, but we got a bit of a break later on in the week. With 49 scouts and 8 leaders, we enjoyed a week of fun activities, Trail to Eagle, Merit Badge classes, campfires and cobbles; as well as, camp wide games. The camp activities included a climbing area, horse corral, BMX bike track, fishing, rifle & shotgun shooting, archery, crafts and an amazing waterfront with swimming, small boat sailing, row boats and kayaking.

We had 2 adults and 3 scouts complete the 1 mile swim around the lake. The camp offered a variety of 58 different Merit Badges and our scouts took advantage of them, earning a total of over 180 complete Merit Badges with 30 partials. The Panther Patrol got the most with 35 completed Merit Badges. We even had three rank advancements while at camp. Our leaders even took advantage of the training certifications being offered in Paddling & Small Boat, Swim & Rescue, and CPR & First Aid. Our Troop now has 3 BSA trained Lifeguards. All in all, a great week at camp!

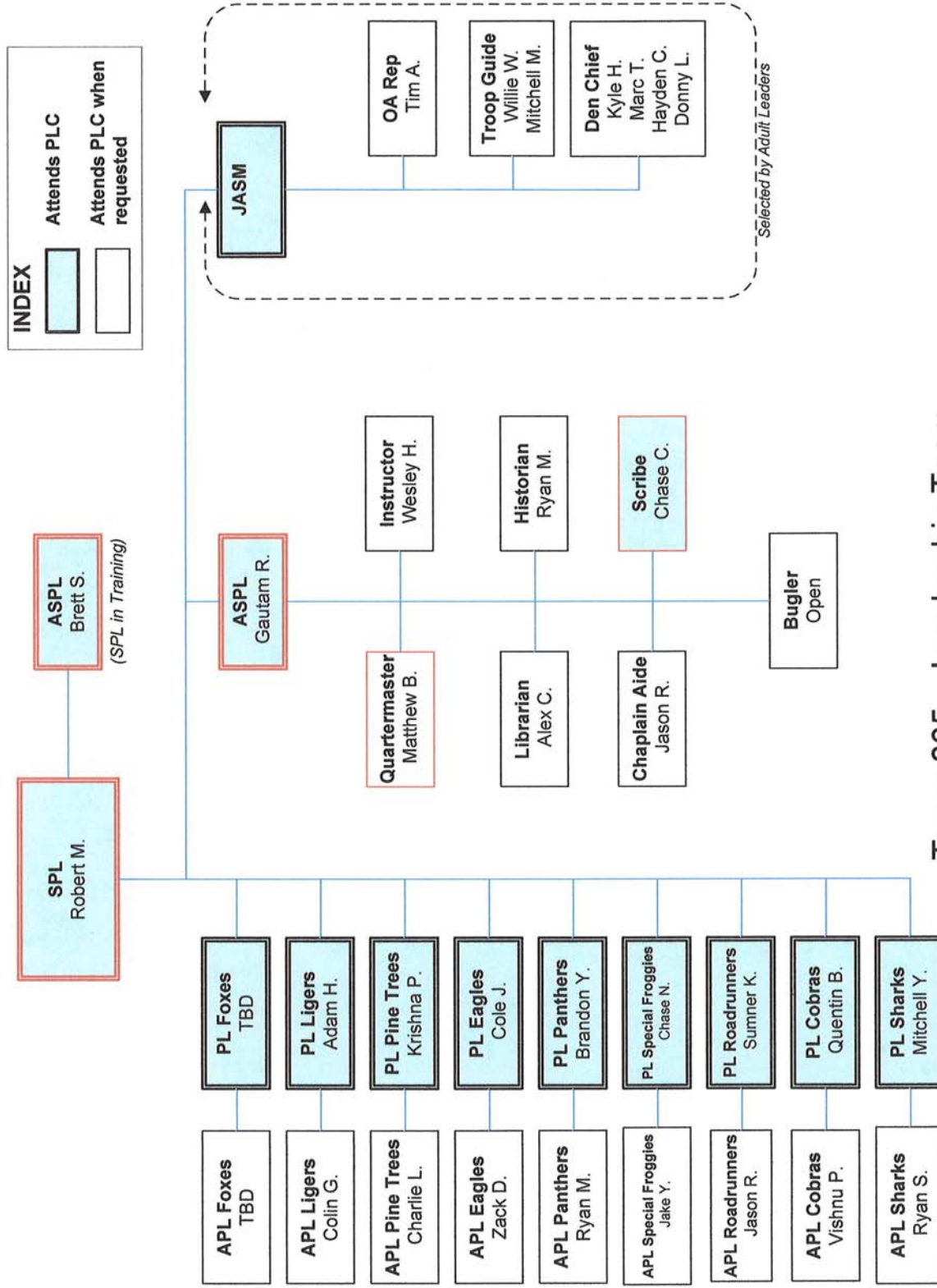
